


What is Open Source?

Open-source software is a type of computer software in which source code is released under a license in which the copyright holder grants users the rights to use, study, change, and distribute the software to anyone and for any purpose.



"Contributing to open source can be a rewarding way to learn, teach and build experience in just about any skill you can imagine."

















git remote add upstream https://github.com/orgname/reponame.git // only once to add remote upstream url


Open source itself is great, but the community is more important. It's not just about contributing to this project or that project. You actually get to be part of the community and interact with people.




